1. What is the first Bible you owned? Who gave it to you? What did you do with it?
2. How would you describe your engagement with the Bible? Difficult to get into. Don't know where to start. Learning to read profitably and get something out of it. Have trouble disciplining myself to read consistently. I can't get enough of it.
3. Read Psalm 19:1-6. This speaks about general revelation from nature. If you are a believer, what sense of the general revelation of God do you recall before your became a Christian? Did you have a sense that there must be a God by virtue of the witness of nature or your conscience? Explain.
4. Read Psalm 19:7-11. There are several words that all refer to the special revelation of the written word of God (law, statutes, precepts, commands, fear of the Lord, ordinances). What can the word of God do in affecting our lives? Examine each of the verses.
5. God wants to reveal himself to us. The primary way he makes himself know is by the Bible. Our reading and obeying Scripture is critical to our spiritual development and relationship with God. What could do in your Bible reading habits to be further shaped by God?
