GATHER WITH CHRIST FOLLOWERS

- 1. Describe a time when you needed to forgive someone. Describe a time when someone needed to forgive you.
- 2. Read John 8:1–8. What do you think this woman must have been thinking and feeling? What and why do you think Jesus was writing in the dust?
- 3. Read John 8:9 11. In vs 10 Jesus asked this woman, "Where are your accusers?" How would you answer that question for yourself? Who tries to remind you of your sin or keep you stuck in your past? How do you think God wants us to interact with our accusers?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus didn't condemn this woman? How do you think she lived after that?
- 5. Read Romans 7:14 8:1. If you are a Christ-follower, God doesn't condemn you. Do you really believe that? Since that's true, how should we live in response to that?
- 6. Since there is no condemnation for Christ-followers, does that mean we can live any way we want? Read Romans 6 for reference.

GO TELL OTHERS ABOUT JESUS WITH YOUR LIFE AND WORDS
