

Jesus On The Cross: The Seven Words Of Christ

The Victory

John 19:30

30 Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

On the cross Jesus won. And when Jesus won, we won. Sin was defeated. All that was left was the resurrection.

At The Cross, Victory Was Certain

In all of the New Testament, very few words are as significant as "it is finished."

At the cross the death of Christ paid the sin debt in full

At the cross the death of Christ put salvation into effect

At the cross the death of Christ accomplished his mission

"It is finished" was not a cry of agony or failure, but a cry of victory.

His death demonstrated the enormity of man's sin and the enormity of God's love

At The Cross, God Showed Us He Loves Us

God's love moves Him to save us not condemn us.

When Jesus was through doing everything needed to save us, he cried out in victory, "It is finished."
