Worship at Zion

The Zion worship service has a structure and sequence that reflects the way scripture shows how God meets his people. God has made himself known to the world in Jesus Christ, who is God the Son, who took on human flesh, bled and died for our sins, rose from the dead, ascended to the Father's right hand, intercedes for us now, and will come again to receive us at the end. The church assembles on the Lord's day to name the name of Jesus, which is above every name.

- We enter his courts with thanksgiving and praise
- We kneel before him in confession and repentance
- We stand and hear again the Gospel's promise of mercy and forgiveness
- We bring our tribute offerings to our King
- We hear the voice of God from scripture
- We eat at the table Jesus has provided for us
- We depart with his blessing and promise that He will be with us until he comes for us again.

Ezra and Nehemiah: God Stirs Up His People "God's People Return with Ezra" Ezra 7 (pew Bible p. 393) Sermon Notes: 28 May 2023

Big Idea: Because God's hand is on his people, Christians must study and do God's word.

Problem: People don't see the beauty of what God is doing right in front of them.

Christians need the beauty of God's word in how they: I. Live (vv. 1-10)

II. Build (vv. 11-24)

III. Remember (vv. 25-28)

Ezra 7:1-10, 27-28

Now after this, in the reign of Artaxerxes king of Persia, Ezra the son of Seraiah, son of Azariah, son of Hilkiah, 2 son of Shallum, son of Zadok, son of Ahitub, 3 son of Amariah, son of Azariah, son of Meraioth, 4 son of Zerahiah, son of Uzzi, son of Bukki, 5 son of Abishua, son of Phinehas, son of Eleazar, son of Aaron the chief priest-- 6 this Ezra went up from Babylonia. He was a scribe skilled in the Law of Moses that the LORD, the God of Israel, had given, and the king granted him all that he asked, for the hand of the LORD his God was on him. 7 And there went up also to Jerusalem, in the seventh year of Artaxerxes the king, some of the people of Israel, and some of the priests and Levites, the singers and gatekeepers, and the temple servants. 8 And Ezra came to Jerusalem in the fifth month, which was in the seventh year of the king. 9 For on the first day of the first month he began to go up from Babylonia, and on the first day of the fifth month he came to Jerusalem, for the good hand of his God was on him. 10 For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the LORD, and to do it and to teach his statutes and rules in Israel. ...

27 Blessed be the LORD, the God of our fathers, who put such a thing as this into the heart of the king, to beautify the house of the LORD that is in Jerusalem, 28 and who extended to me his steadfast love before the king and his counselors, and before all the king's mighty officers. I took courage, for the hand of the LORD my God was on me, and I gathered leading men from Israel to go up with me.

Questions for Further Discussion:

- Why did the king grant Ezra all that he asked (v. 6)?
- Why is it called the Law of Moses if the LORD gave it? How do those two phrases in v. 6 work together to teach us something about Scripture?
- What three things does v. 10 tell us about Ezra's relationship to the law of God? Is the order important? Why?
- Describe all the ways that King Artaxerxes is generous to Ezra and God's people. (vv. 11-24)
- Is Ezra going to lead God's people alone? Which people will lead with him?
- How does Ezra respond in v. 28 to all these things?
- How is God with you in a similar way that he is with Ezra?
- How is God with you in a better way than he was with Ezra?


YTD Giving through March/Q1 2023 = \$262K YTD Expenses through March/Q1 2023 = \$221K




