**GATHER -** GATHER WITH A SMALL GROUP OF CHRIST FOLLOWERS TO LEARN HOW TO LIVE IN BIBLICAL COMMUNITY.

The following starter questions are for personal reflection or group discussion. They are taken from the message given at Epic. You can listen to this message at theepicchurch.com or download it from iTunes.

- 1) Read John 12:23 24. What happens to a kernel of wheat that isn't planted in the soil? How are people today fulfilling that verse? Are you "alone" according to that verse?
- 2) Read John 12:24. What does dying to ourselves produce? How have you seen that happen in life? What might you need to die to so others might find Jesus?
- 3) The "dying process" is always very difficult. Why do you think that is? Why is that hard for you?
- 4) Read Galatians 2:20. What part of your life needs to be crucified with Christ?
- 5) Describe what could happen in our lives and in our community if we as a church died to ourselves and really lived for God. What might you need to die to for that to happen?
- 6) Read Matthew 9:37 38. How do we get more workers to help gather the harvest? Are you doing that?
- 7) Read Malachi 3:10. What promise is there in this verse? Are you putting God to the test according to this verse? If so what has your experience been like? If not what is holding you back from engaging this?
