

Worship Jesus
John 12:12-19

I. We worship with our praise John 12:12,13

A. Preparation for his coming (12)

12 The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

B. Praising him at his coming (13)

13 took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: “Hosanna! *Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD! The King of Israel!*”

II. We worship with our giving John 12:14,15

14 Then Jesus, when He had found a young donkey, sat on it; as it is written:

15 “*Fear not, daughter of Zion; Behold, your King is coming, Sitting on a donkey’s colt.*”

16 His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things were written about Him and *that* they had done these things to Him.

A. Jesus’ triumphal entry is a fulfillment of prophecy

B. Jesus’ donkey was a gift for the furtherance of the gospel

III. We worship with our testimony John 12:16-19

A. The testimony of the witness of Lazarus’ resurrection (17,18)

17 Therefore the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, bore witness. 18 For this reason the people also met Him, because they heard that He had done this sign.

B. The response to those who are testifying about Jesus (19)

19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, “You see that you are accomplishing nothing. Look, the world has gone after Him!”
