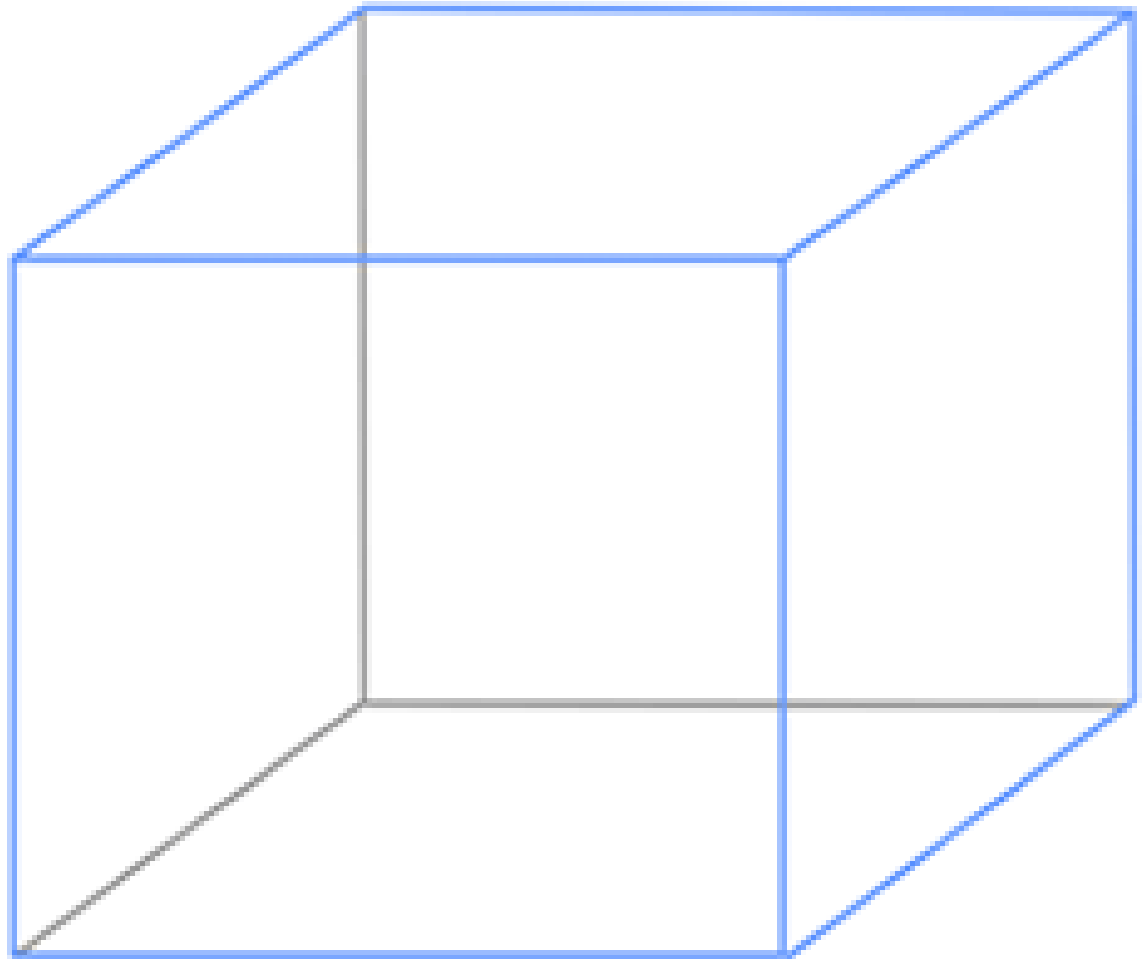

Many have fallen away from the faith because we only exercise faith in one dimension.






Dimension:

- The range of the degree to which something extends
- A level of existence or consciousness

The first dimension is personal connection.

It represents a line from one point to another (from you to God).

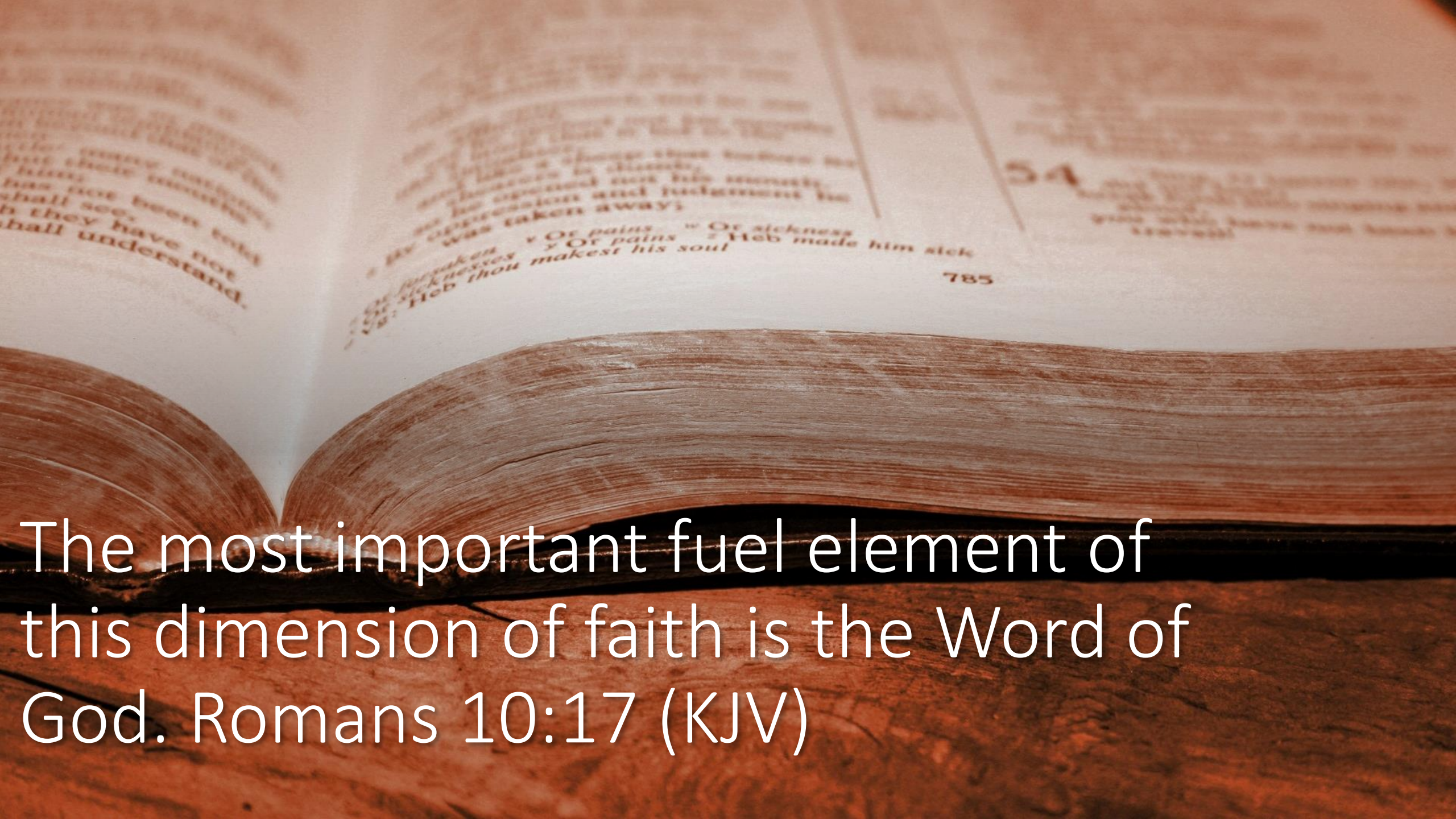


Motivation and focus of this dimension is self.
