SERMON NOTES

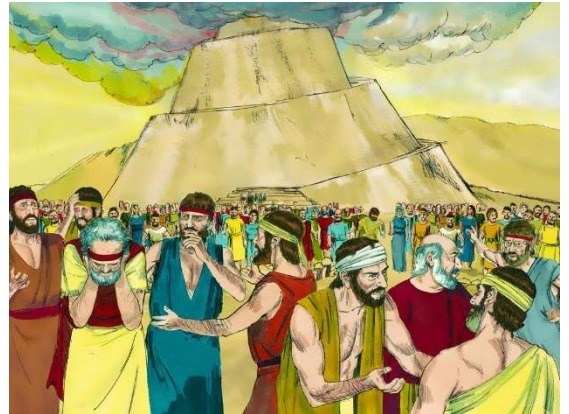
Mankind is arrogant, but God still cares and loves us.

He offers Christ as a solution to our sin problem.

Genesis 11:1-9

1. Mankind's arrogance (v. 1-4)

Let us build stuff and make a name for ourselves.



2. God knows what's going on (V. 5-6)

God knows what the end result is for these people if he does not intervene.

He still loves us and cares about our lives.

3. God's action and solution (V. 7-9)

The tower builders wanted to settle on one place and reach God. God reversed their plan and scattered them around the world.

Key Point: God calls us to build His kingdom not our own.

LIFE APPLICATION

**How can we give our whole selves (head, hands, and heart)?*

God calls us to build His kingdom not our own

Analyze (Search):

“Search me, O God, and know my heart...” – Psalm 139:23

- May we look at our own hearts to see where those areas of arrogance are. They are there.
- Do we love God more than we love ourselves?

Adjust (Practice):

“Be doers of the word, and not hearers only...” – James 1:22

- Will I spend more time in God’s word to shift my focus from me to Him?
- What do I need to change in my life to aid in shifting that focus?

Adore (Worship):

“From Him and through Him and to Him are all things...” – Romans 11:36

- Thank the Lord for His mercy and grace to you.
- In spite of our sin He loves us and offers to us a solution in Christ.
- May the Holy Spirit encourage our hearts to love Him and follow Him.
