DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What did you think about the message?
- 2. Do you like things that are slow? Do you like to drive slow?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-7. What do you notice about the passage? What does this passage tell us about God?
- 4. Paul is nothing without love. How are you doing when it comes to loving other people? Are nothing, as the Apostle Paul says? Do you agree with Paul's statement?
- 5. Love is patient. What does patience have to do with loving someone?
- 6. Love is not self-serving, it is not easily angered, it honors another person. What do all these things have in common?
- 7. Slowing down will make us more loving people. In what ways is slowing down going to be a challenge? How can this group pray for you?
- 8. In the message, Paul listed some different ways we can slow down. Which ones do you plan to apply to your life?
