PP Jude-Christian...Contend For Jesus!

Part 4-1:4b 9/28-29

If we do not care about the truth, we will not be that bothered by those who distort it

Peter warned his readers what some false teachers were doing with Paul's teaching: "which the

ignorant and unstable twist to their own destruction, as they do the other Scriptures."

2 Peter 3:16

A person can twist scripture in nearly infinite ways to suit their preferences and biases

PP Is that really what the verse he pointed to saying: "Woe to him who makes his neighbors drink—you pour out your wrath and make them drunk, in order to gaze at their nakedness!" Habakkuk 2:15

It is wrong to make someone drunk so that you can take advantage of them, and it is wrong for Babylon, to who God is speaking here, to intoxicate a nation with their favor and then crush them militarily

Drinking excessively is sin, but to use this verse as proof that Jesus didn't actually turn water into wine with alcoholic content is absurd

There is bad teaching, and there is false and heretical teaching

Jude was exposing false teaching because he knew it was poison, as did Charles Spurgeon

PP "I cannot endure false doctrine, however neatly it may be put before me. Would you have me
eat poisoned meat because the dish is of the choicest ware?"

Spurgeon

Jude sees heresy creeping into the church and he's calling Christians to contend for the faith Last week we looked at the <u>first</u> heresy: "For certain people have crept in unnoticed who long ago were designated for this condemnation, ungodly people, who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality "who pervert the grace of our God into sensuality"

Cheap grace, or hyper-grace, the teaching that since all our sins were put on Christ and He paid for them all, then it doesn't matter when we sin

Instead of grace moving us to holy living, it actually created a license to sin all you want or a sense that you can get to the point where you are no longer a sinner

But then Jude warned of a second heresy: some "deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ."

PP 'deny' means to disown, for the followers of Jesus who fearing death or persecution, deny that Jesus is their Master and desert His cause

They were disowning not an idea, but a Person, Jesus Christ

The King James almost makes it appear that Jude is talking of two persons: "denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ." 4

But the Greek grammar requires these two names to refer to one Person Jude is saying here that Jesus Christ is God!

PP He is the 'Master', a word that gives us our word despot, not a tyrant who abuses his power, but a ruler with absolute power and authority

Anyone who denies that Jesus was fully man and fully God fully all His time on earth is a false teacher

PP Michael Horton points out in Agony of Deceit, that "any teaching that denies that Christ is `the only begotten Son, the One and Only incarnation of God' is heresy"

PP Not only is Jesus supreme in authority, He is the '*Lord*', *the honorable owner of all* He was more than a good man, or a good teacher, and His authority was not derived from God The authority of Jesus is His own, because He is God in flesh

False teaching almost always has a problem with the authority of Jesus Christ

So Jude ends his letter with the strongest affirmation of this possible: "to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever." 25

Jude is affirming in verse 4 what the false teachers were denying...that Jesus was God in man, the supreme authority and rightful owner of all there is

Most of us struggle in this area of authority, finding it difficult to fully yield to God with hearts in full agreement with His will

Has God clearly asked you to do something that you are, quite honestly, not yet willing to do? Has He allowed or even brought something into your life that you are struggling to accept? Following the Lord in that moment may be the most difficult choice you'll ever make It is at that moment you'll discover if Jesus is your Master and Lord

Notice the word Jude uses here: 'only'

This is a clue, identifying the heresy was, creeping into the church, and it is strengthened when we look at verse 25, and see it there as well: "to the <u>only</u> God, our Savior"

PP It had a name, and it is still very much alive; it's called Gnosticism

This has been one of the greatest threats to the church in all its history, often changing in form It was a cult philosophy that believed that the Supreme God was completely unknowable and too pure to touch physical matter because matter was intrinsically evil

So he/she created divinities, or Aeons, each one further and further removed from his presence The last one created was so removed from the supreme God that he was ignorant and evil This final divinity was the God of the Old Testament, the creator of the universe, who blinded the eyes of unbelievers and kept humans from knowing who they really were Who people really are, are divine sparks of light, offshoots of God trapped in a corrupt body

So the supreme God created another divinity, the redeemer Christ, more like he/she than the creator god

Christ came to rescue these elect sparks, giving them knowledge of who they are, so that their eyes could be opened and they could realize that they are divine

The Christ did not come to redeem the elect from sin, but from ignorance, and when these few realized who they were, sparks of divinity, gods within, they began their journey back to the Supreme God

But the Gnostics were divided in their view of Christ

Some believed, since all matter was evil and God cannot touch it, the Christ appeared to be a man, but was really just a spirit in the illusion of a body

Others believed that the Christ came into the man Jesus at His baptism and then left him on the cross

Either belief united in the purpose of Christ, to give secret knowledge to the ignorant

- The body was evil and a prison to be escaped from with some teaching that since it was evil and utterly separate from the pure spirit within, it didn't matter what you did with it, so sin as much as you want
- Other Gnostics argued that one must separate from all desires of the flesh and control it
 But both taught that salvation, enlightenment, started with the knowledge that Christ came to
 give, and continue with gnostic teachings, visions, dreams, experiences, rituals, as well as
 directly from angels
- Eventually for the elect few enlightened Gnostics, death started the spirit's journey back to a reunion with the Supreme God forever
- Jesus isn't the only God, we are all gods, we need not forgiveness of sin, but secret knowledge
- This is the original strategy of Satan, and it works so well, he keeps using it, outside the church as well as inside it, as Self-help guru Wayne Dyer presents:

- PP "But the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." Genesis 3:4-5

Eat the fruit, your eyes will be open to know...and when you know, you will be like God And this is what Gnosticism taught; that we have within us the divine spark, the potential to become gods, and what awakens it is this secret knowledge

And what prevents us from being on this path of enlightenment is not sin, but ignorance

So Jude wrote that some "deny our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ.

Friends, do you realize that many are teaching these same heresies today?

PP Rhonda Byrne in the promo of her book, <u>The Magic</u> says: "For more than twenty centuries, words within a sacred text have mystified, confused, and been misunderstood by almost all who read them. Only a very few people through history have realized that the words are a riddle, and that once you solve the riddle - once you uncover the mystery - a new world will appear before your eyes. In The Magic, Rhonda Byrne reveals this lifechanging knowledge to the world."

PP revelation: "Now I don't know what hell looks like but God gave me a few ideas. It is hot, fire hot but at the same time it is cold and clammy. That is kind of different isn't it? Fire hot, but cold and clammy." Joyce Meyer

How about the Gnostic belief that the Christ left Jesus on the cross so He was just a man?

- **PP** "[Jesus] could have helped himself up until the point where he said I commend my spirit into your hands, at that point he couldn't do nothing for himself anymore. He had become sin, he was no longer the Son of God. He was sin." Joyce Meyer
- **PP** "Why didn't Jesus openly proclaim Himself as God during His 33 years on earth?" For one single reason, "He hadn't come to earth as God, He'd come as man." Kenneth Copeland
- PP Paul was battling the beginnings of Gnostic heresy at Colossae when he wrote: "See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit...For in [Christ] the whole

fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in Him, who is the head of all rule and authority." Colossians 2:8-10

Word-Faith teachers like Copeland, Hagin, Price and Dollar not only demote Christ to bring Him to our level, they promote humans to be on His

PP Or listen again to what Kenneth Copeland said, "You don't have a God in you, you are one" and "When I read in the Bible where (Jesus) says, 'I am,' I say, 'Yes, I am too.'" And because we are gods, Copeland says, "Pray to yourself"
