Practicing Heart Attitude #7...

- **Beginner:** Intentionally choose NOT to argue, complain, or gossip when a leader over you makes a decision you disagree with.
- · Intermediate: Ask appropriate questions, but be easily persuaded by your leaders.
- **Advanced:** Clear up with a leader (and any others present) if you have gossiped or complained about their direction or decisions

- What are your biggest personal challenges in following spiritual leadership?
- · How have you benefited when you have followed spiritual leadership within Scriptural limits?
