The Frauds

NLT Col. 2. 8 Don't let anyone capture you with empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense that come from human thinking and from the spiritual powers of this world, rather than from Christ. 9 For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body.

The false teachers made God amoral

8 the one who practices sin is of the devil; for the devil has sinned from the beginning. The Son of God appeared for this purpose, to destroy the works of the devil.

The false teachers were and are frauds. They and their teachings destroy any hope of a relationship with God.

The Father

Father implies relationship

3.1 See how great a love the Father has bestowed on us, that we would be called children of God; and such we are. For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

The Father who sent His Son is the Father who loves us.

The Children

2 Beloved, now we are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, because we will see Him just as He is.

3 And everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure.

God loves us and will restore our relationship with Him through Jesus.

Eternal Life means we will see Jesus, be with Jesus and the Father, and in some way be like Jesus.
