

### THE BOTTOM LINE

## THE DIVINE MENTOR

But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate won't come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. – John 16:7 NLT

## KNOW—WHAT DOES THIS TELL ME ABOUT WHO GOD IS?

And this is the way to have eternal life—to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one you sent to earth.  
– John 17:3 NLT

## DO—WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR ME?

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. – James 1:22 NIV

Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. – James 1:23-24 NIV

But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, –not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it— they will be blessed in what they do. – James 1:25 NLT/NIV
