God Reveals Himself To Us

All we can ever know about God is what He wants us to know.
We call that Revelation.

Inspiration: God is the author or source

Infallibility: In matters of truth, no mistake exists

Inerrancy: In factual matters no error exists

Authority And Authenticity

19 So we have the prophetic word made more sure,

...to which you do well to pay attention as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star arises in your hearts.

20 But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation,

21 for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.

Authority means it came from God.

Authentic means its real and trustworthy. Peter testifies to both.

In Scripture, The Bible, God tells us what He wants us to know

about Himself and His plan for our salvation.

If you want to know God, read the Bible.

If you don't read the Bible, it's hard to know God.
