John 2:13-16

13 It was nearly time for the Jewish Passover celebration, so Jesus went to Jerusalem. 14 In the Temple area he saw merchants selling cattle, sheep, and doves for sacrifices; he also saw dealers at tables exchanging foreign money.
15 Jesus made a whip from some ropes and chased them all out of the Temple. He drove out the sheep and cattle, scattered the money changers' coins over the floor, and turned over their tables. 16 Then, going over to the people who sold doves, he told them, "Get these things out of here. Stop turning my Father's house into a marketplace!"

Amos 5:18-24

18 What sorrow awaits you who say, "If only the day of the LORD were here!" You have no idea what you are wishing for. That day will bring darkness, not light. 19 In that day you will be like a man who runs from a lion—only to meet a bear. Escaping from the bear, he leans his hand against a wall in his house—and he's bitten by a snake. 20 Yes, the day of the LORD will be dark and hopeless, without a ray of joy or hope. 21 "I hate all your show and pretense—the hypocrisy of your religious festivals and solemn assemblies. 22 I will not accept your burnt offerings and grain offerings. I won't even notice all your choice peace offerings. 23 Away with your noisy hymns of praise! I will not listen to the music of your harps. 24 Instead, I want to see a mighty flood of justice, an endless river of righteous living.

17 Then his disciples remembered this prophecy from the Scriptures: "Passion for God's house will consume me." **18**



But the Jewish leaders demanded, "What are you doing? If God gave you authority to do this, show us a miraculous sign to prove it." **19** "All right," Jesus replied. "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." **20** "What!" they exclaimed. "It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple, and you can rebuild it in three days?" **21** But when Jesus said "this temple," he meant his own body. **22** After he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered he had said this, and they believed both the Scriptures (which prophesied His resurrection) and what Jesus had said.

John 2:23-25

23 Because of the miraculous signs Jesus did in Jerusalem at the Passover celebration, many began to trust in him. **24** But Jesus didn't trust them, because he knew all about people. **25** No one needed to tell him about human nature, for he knew what was in each person's heart.
