1. You Will Be Addressed

Humility begins with seeing who God is, seeing yourself compared to God, and then seeing yourself as God sees you.

2. You Will Be Affected (2:2)

***Everything God calls
you to do he gives you
a greater grace.***

3. You Will Be Assigned

(2:3-5)

To hear the Word of the Lord is to bring a hardening of the heart.

4. You Will Be Assured

(2:6-7)

Our assurance is not how much our hearts are set on God, but how unshakably his heart is set on us--& he proved this by coming back from the dead!

5. You Will Be Attended to
(2:8-10)

The tear-wiping hand of God comes to us freely because the wrath-bearing hand of God fell on Jesus fully.
