6. Read Ephesians 2:10 and 1 Peter 4:10. What do these verses say to you about serving?
7. “Learning more and more about God without serving is like eating all the time without exercise.” Share your thoughts as to whether you agree or disagree with this statement?
8. Share your answer to the following questions with your group?
 - A. Where is God nudging you to serve?
 - B. How do you want to push back away from God’s nudge?
