"Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them... A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them." Matthew 7:15-20

#### In Matthew 23, Jesus describes leaders with "bad fruit":

- Overly authoritarian (vv. 8–12) Issue burdensome rules (v. 4)
- Love attention and titles (vv. 5–7) Convert people to a system (vv. 13–15) Focus on precise rules, not big picture (vv. 23–24)
