Perspective...

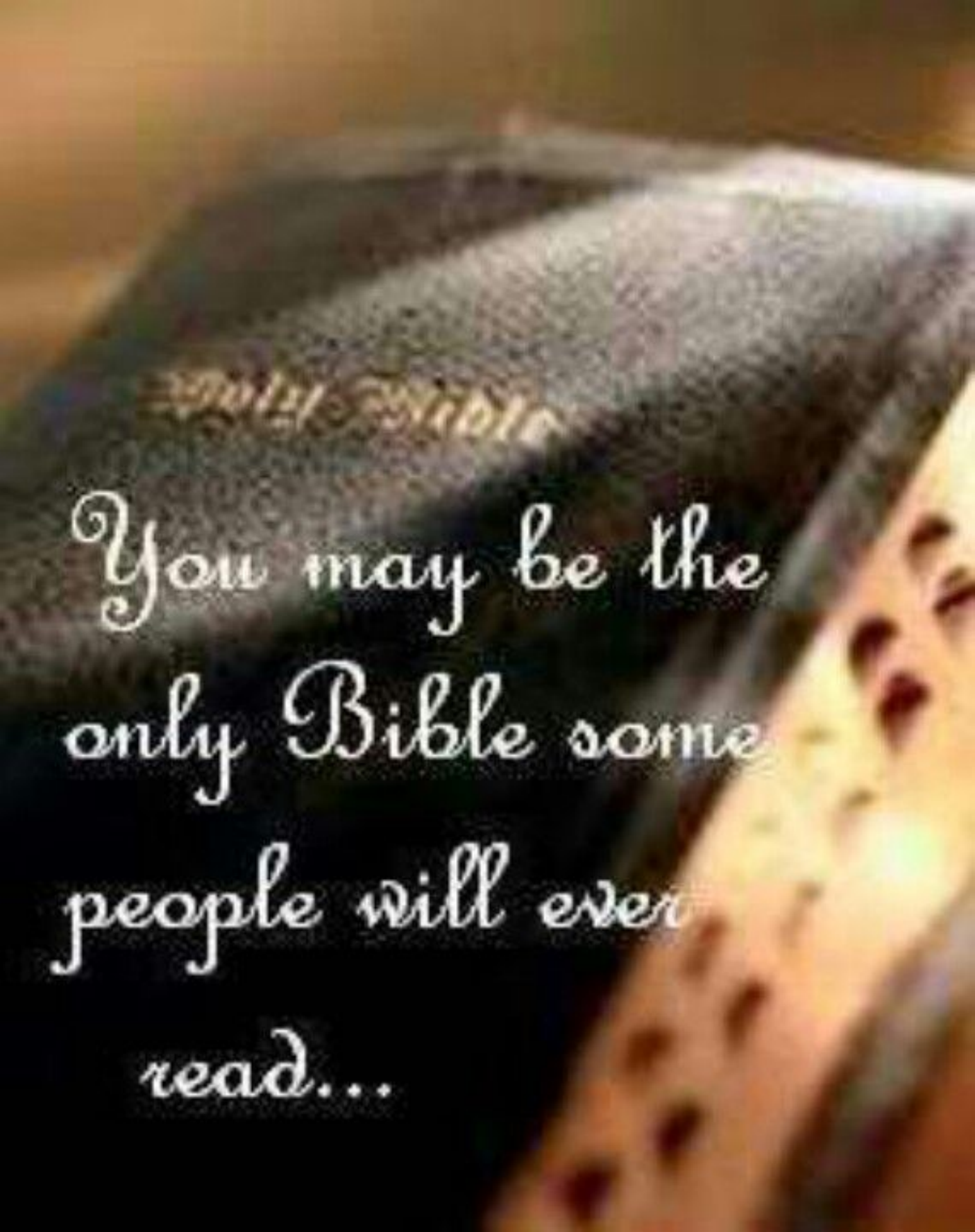

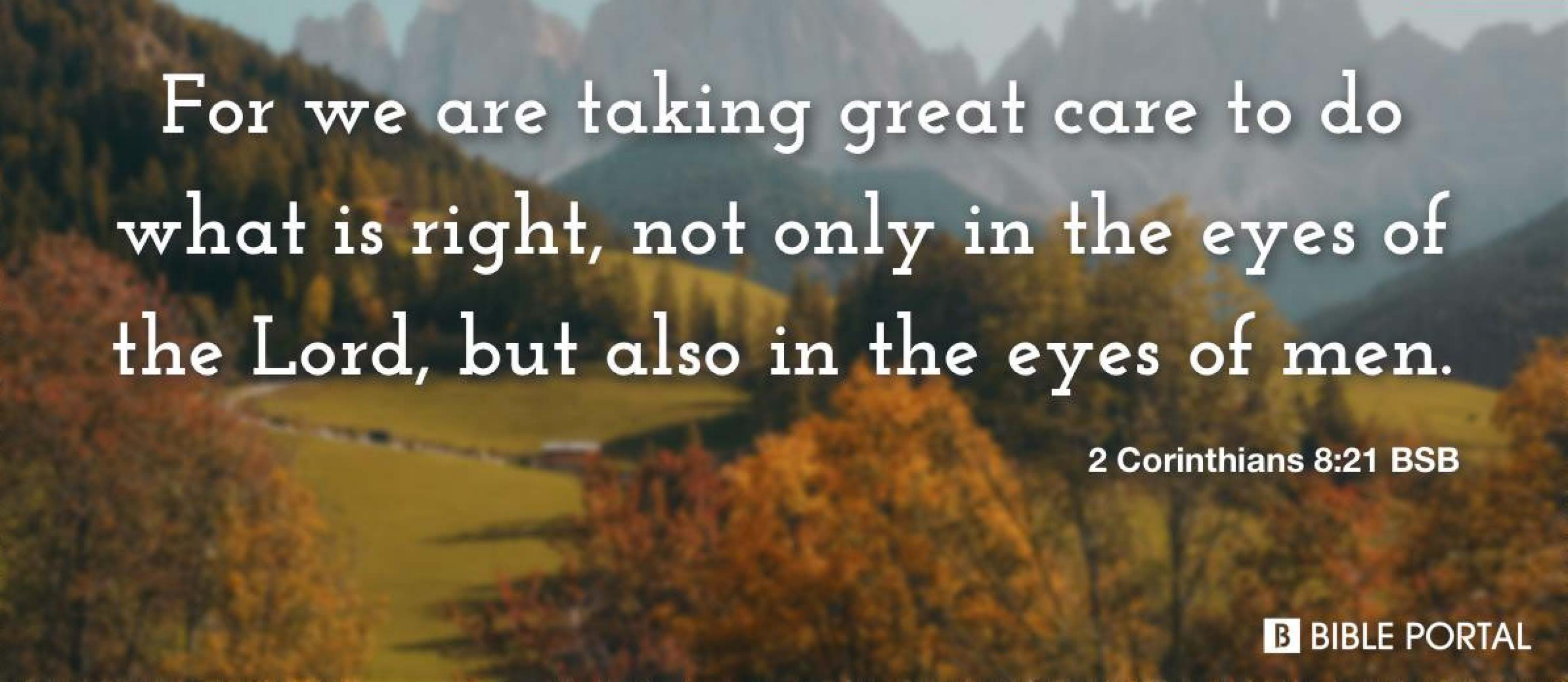

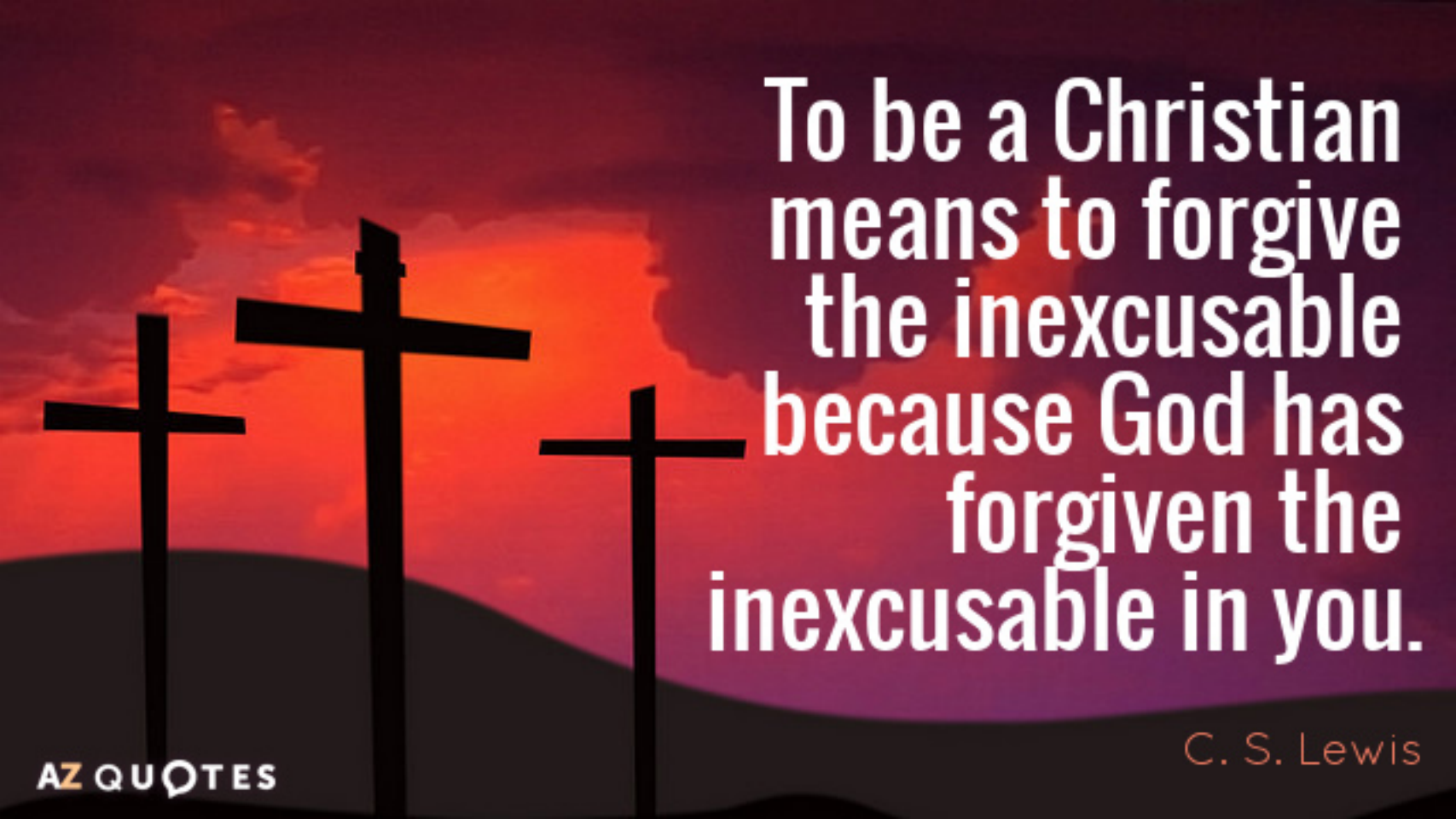
