Discussion Questions

What does it mean to you that faith is described as 'the reality of what is hoped for, the proof of what is not seen' in Hebrews 11:1?

- Pastor talked about faith being the expectation of what is to come, even if we can't see it right now.
- Can you think of a situation in your life where you had to trust in something you couldn't see? How did that feel?

In the sermon, Pastor mentions the importance of obedience to God over knowledge. Why do you think obedience is so important in demonstrating faith?

- Pastor emphasized that God desires our obedience and that it leads to transformation instead of just having knowledge.
- In what areas of your life do you think God is asking you to be more obedient?

How do you relate to the idea of living by holy confidence in Christ, as discussed in the sermon?

- Pastor talked about having holy confidence that comes from believing in Jesus and what He accomplished for us.
- Can you think of a time when your confidence in Jesus helped you face a challenge?

Pastor mentioned various figures in Hebrews 11, like Noah and Abraham, who acted in faith despite not seeing the outcomes. What do you think we can learn from their stories?

- The sermon highlighted how these individuals had faith and acted on it, even when they didn't receive all the promises in their lifetime.
- How can their experiences inspire you to step out in faith in your own life?

Why do you think Pastor encourages the congregation to keep their eyes looking forward instead of back at the past?

- Pastor pointed out that looking forward signifies faith and trusting God's plan for the future, rather than dwelling on past disappointments.
- What is one thing from your past that you need to let go of to focus on your future with God?

- Ask for prayer requests and lift them up to God.
- Pray for strength to live out the faith we are called to demonstrate.
- Ask God to help us recognize the steps of obedience in our daily lives.
- Pray for boldness in sharing our faith with those around us.
