Two Generations (1:1-6)

God's people repented, showing they are not like their forefathers who disobeyed

Two Returns (1:7-17)

God responds in returning now in relationship and in future in his presence

God knows the world is at peace while his people suffer (1:7-12)

God's 2 returns will fix this (1:13-17)

Two 4's (1:18-21)

God will return in his temple to defeat his people's enemies

Two Cities (2:1-13)

God's return means his people must love Jerusalem, not Babylon

Flee Babylon, for God will bring judgement (2:6-9)

Rejoice in Jerusalem, for God will protect the city Jerusalem where he dwells (2:1-5, 10-13)
