Read 1 Peter 2:9

1. Can you articulate why 1 Peter 2:9 is so difficult for us to understand on a personal level?
2. Look at the following verses regarding your identity in Christ. How do these verses change your approach to worship? We are children of God (John 1:12) Friends of God (John 15:15), more than conquerors (Rom. 8:37), chosen and dearly loved (Col. 3:12), citizens of heaven (Phil. 3:20), the redeemed (Gal. 3:13), saints (Eph. 1:18) a holy nation (1 Peter 2:9) and a kingdom of priests (Rev. 1:6).

Read Exodus 19:5-6

3. How did Israel go from being called a nation of priests to only having one tribe represent them as priests?" (Hint: Read Exodus 32:25-29)

Read 1 Peter 2:5

4. If Peter is speaking to the church or Christians, how does this speak to the way you function in the church?
5. When you read Deuteronomy 10:8-9, what do you identify with as your role as a Christ follower?
