### II Peter 2:15-17 Number 22

#### I. The deviance of Balaam II Peter 2:15-16

**15 They have forsaken the right way and gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Beor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; 16 but he was rebuked for his iniquity: a dumb donkey speaking with a man's voice restrained the madness of the prophet.**

- A. Balaam is an example of false prophets who have forsaken the right way (15)
- B. Balaam was remorseful but not repentant (16)
- C. Balaam went the wrong way (15)

#### II. The deviant's work is dry and leads to eternal darkness II Peter 2:17

**17 These are wells without water, clouds carried by a tempest, for whom is reserved the blackness of darkness forever.**

- A. Worthless words that don't quench your thirst.
- B. Worthless promises that never come
- C. Worthless workers have a dark dungeon before them

3. The deviant teacher is destined to doom in a dark dungeon.
