SERMON NOTES

Man Kills Man

Genesis 4:1-16

- 1. We need to be honest about our worship. (vv.1-8)
 - a. The Heart of Worship



b. The Result of Wrong Worship

Key Point: Proper hatred towards sin is driven by the realization that all it wants is to kill us.

- 2. We need to be covered by a better Worshiper. (vv.9-16)
 - a. God's Grace towards Cain.
 - b. God's Grace in Christ.

Key Point: In Jesus the mercy and justice of God meet and are completely satisfied.

NEED PRAYER?

LIFE APPLICATION

*How can we give our whole selves (head, hands, and heart)?

How Do I Apply This in My Life?

Analyze: Do you distinguish between corporate worship (church on Sundays) and personal worship (every day, every activity)? What steps do you take in each of those areas to evaluate your heart offering? How can Jesus' perfect worship cover your lack?

Adjust: 1) Connect Worship to Cost: King David said, "I will not sacrifice to the Lord my God burnt offerings that cost me nothing," (2 Samuel 24:24). Though we aren't able or responsible for supplying a perfect offering to God (that comes from Jesus), we are expected to worship with sacrifice. What about your worship comes at a personal cost?

- 2) Connect Worship to Anger: The last couple of messages have shown us that anger is a heart issue that is ultimately directed at God. When we become angry about the things that don't go our way, we are blaming the One who could've altered the circumstances. Our anger and blame hinder our worship and joy. Learn to connect the dots between anger and worship and ask God to receive Jesus' perfect worship on your behalf. Let Him soften your anger in the process.
- 3) Receive the Shocking Grace Offered: Just like Cain, God offers us mercy and grace that is wildly undeserved. Rather than responding flippantly at God because we wanted things our way, recognize the offer of the moment and how incredible it is that we would get another shot at a relationship with Him. Just humble yourself and receive it!

Adore (Worship): While there are some things in this world that still work for the good, we are often fixated on the ugly parts that fail. The blood of Jesus speaks a "better word" of redemption and liberation. We know that in Him is our great rescue. All the brokenness we see will one day be made right in Him.
