## Devotion Info *Stewards Of The Tabernacle*

### **DAY 1: Read Exodus 25:8, 29:42-46**

*[8] "Have the people of Israel build me a holy sanctuary so I can live among them.*  
Exodus 25:8 NLT

*[42] "These burnt offerings are to be made each day from generation to generation. Offer them in the Lord's presence at the Tabernacle entrance; there I will meet with you and speak with you. [43] I will meet the people of Israel there, in the place made holy by my glorious presence. [44] Yes, I will consecrate the Tabernacle and the altar, and I will consecrate Aaron and his sons to serve me as priests. [45] Then I will live among the people of Israel and be their God, [46] and they will know that I am the Lord their God. I am the one who brought them out of the land of Egypt so that I could live among them. I am the Lord their God.*  
Exodus 29:42-46 NLT

- In verse 43, what is being sanctified, and how does the reader today understand it differently than when it was first written for the nation of Israel?

### **DAY 2: Read Exodus 3:14 and 6:3**

*[14] God replied to Moses, "I Am Who I Am. Say this to the people of Israel: I Am has sent me to you."*  
Exodus 25:8 NLT

*[3] I appeared to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob as El-Shaddai—'God Almighty'—but I did not reveal my name, Yahweh, to them.*  
Exodus 29:42-46 NLT

- What is the ultimate reason God wanted a presence among His people?

### **Application:**

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### **DAY 3: Read Hebrews 8:5, 9:11, and 10:1**

*[5] They serve in a system of worship that is only a copy, a shadow of the real one in heaven. For when Moses was getting ready to build the Tabernacle, God gave him this warning: "Be sure that you make everything according to the pattern I have shown you here on the mountain."*

Hebrews 8:5 NLT

*Hebrews 9:11 NLT*

*[11] So Christ has now become the High Priest over all the good things that have come. He has entered that greater, more perfect Tabernacle in heaven, which was not made by human hands and is not part of this created world.*

Hebrews 9:11 NLT

*[1] The old system under the law of Moses was only a shadow, a dim preview of the good things to come, not the good things themselves. The sacrifices under that system were repeated again and again, year after year, but they were never able to provide perfect cleansing for those who came to worship.*

Hebrews 10:1 NLT

#### **Application:**

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**DAY 5: Read 2 Samuel 6:7-12, 7:9**

*[7] Then the Lord's anger was aroused against Uzzah, and God struck him dead because of this. So Uzzah died right there beside the Ark of God.*

*[8] David was angry because the Lord's anger had burst out against Uzzah. He named that place Perez-uzzah (which means "to burst out against Uzzah"), as it is still called today.*

*[9] David was now afraid of the Lord, and he asked, "How can I ever bring the Ark of the Lord back into my care?" [10] So David decided not to move the Ark of the Lord into the City of David. Instead, he took it to the house of Obed-edom of Gath. [11] The Ark of the Lord remained there in Obed-edom's house for three months, and the Lord blessed Obed-edom and his entire household.*

*[12] Then King David was told, "The Lord has blessed Obed-edom's household and everything he has because of the Ark of God." So David went there and brought the Ark of God from the house of Obed-edom to the City of David with a great celebration.*

*[9] I have been with you wherever you have gone, and I have destroyed all your enemies before your eyes. Now I will make your name as famous as anyone who has ever lived on the earth!*
