- 5. What are some of the biggest distractions today that lull Christians to sleep (ie. entertainment, comfort, busyness, wealth, etc.)? What are some of the biggest distractions for you? How can you guard your heart from those distractions?
- 6. What are some practical responsibilities God has entrusted to you right now? How can you steward those responsibilities with integrity?
- 7. Is there an area of your life where you've been postponing obedience? Why? What are you going to do about it?
- 8. What does it mean to be a faithful steward of what God has entrusted to us?
- 9. What's the difference between guilt-driven effort and stewardship motivated by love for the Master?
- 10. Are you ready for Christ's return? How are you readying yourself for that Day?
