— Sermon Passage —

ROMANS 3:21-26 (NIV - NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION)

3:21 But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the

Prophets testify. **22** This righteousness is given through faith in[a] Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, **23** for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24** and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. **25** God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement,[b] through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished – **26** he did it to demonstrate his

righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.
