The World is Renewed and Restored Genesis 8:1 - 9:17

1. God always remembers. (8:1)

-We can place our trust in every promise God makes.



Key Point: Our FAITH is built upon His promises.

2. A prioritized life pleases God. (8:2-21)

-Making God first in our life brings Him honor and guides our steps.

Key Point: Our FAITH is shown in our actions.

3. We are created with purpose/mission. (9:1-17)

-We have been reconciled and renewed by the blood of Jesus.

-God's grace is evident by the rainbow.

Key Point: Our FAITH leads us to share the gospel with others.

Supporting verses: Luke 16:28; Matthew 7:13-14; Exodus 2:23-24; Hebrews 8:10-12; Ephesians 4:30; Psalm 86:15; Romans 3:23-26; Hebrews 11:7; John 3:16-18.

Adore (Worship):

God, thank you for sending Jesus to die on the cross and paying the price for my sins so I can spend an eternity with You in heaven.

Help me to trust Your promises as I live out my faith in You.

Thank you for the rainbow as it is a joyful reminder of Your power, promise, and provision in my life.
