Contrast is a major theme of the Sermon on the Mount. We've already seen the contrasting values of the Beatitudes. The contrast is the point of salt and light. We will soon see six cases studies in the difference between superficial conformity and radical transformation, between... exterior show and interior change. Then we'll be presented with the difference between doing things to be seen and applauded by others versus doing things to be seen and rewarded by God. Later Jesus will highlight two paths (one narrow, one wide), two types of trees (good and bad), and two foundations (rock and sand). Jesus' followers are to be a stark contrast to the world around them.
