Philippians 1:27

27 Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel

Philippians 1:27 (NLT)

27 ...Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News

Philippians 1:27 (AMP)

27 Only be sure to lead your lives in a manner that is worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit and one purpose, with one mind striving side by side [as if in combat] for the faith of the gospel

Philippians 1:27 (CEV)

27 ... whether I visit you or not, I will hear that you are united in spirit and purpose, working together as one for the faith of the good news

Philippians 2:1–2

1 Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

Philippians 2:2 (AMP)

2 make my joy complete by being of the same mind, having the same love [toward one another], knit together in spirit, intent on one purpose

Philippians 2:2 (AMPC)

2 Fill up and complete my joy by living in harmony and being of the same mind and one in purpose, having the same love, being in full accord and of one harmonious mind and intention

Psalms 133:1

1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!

Deuteronomy 32:30

30 How could one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, unless their Rock had sold them, and the Lord had surrendered them?

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 (NLT)

9 Two people are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. 10 If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble. 11 Likewise, two people lying close together can keep each other warm. But how can one be warm alone? 12 A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer. Three are even better, for a triple-braided cord is not easily broken.

Amos 3:3

3 Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?

2 Timothy 2:3-4

15 but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ— 16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

24 Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. 25 And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.
