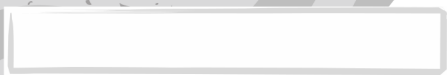

## FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT

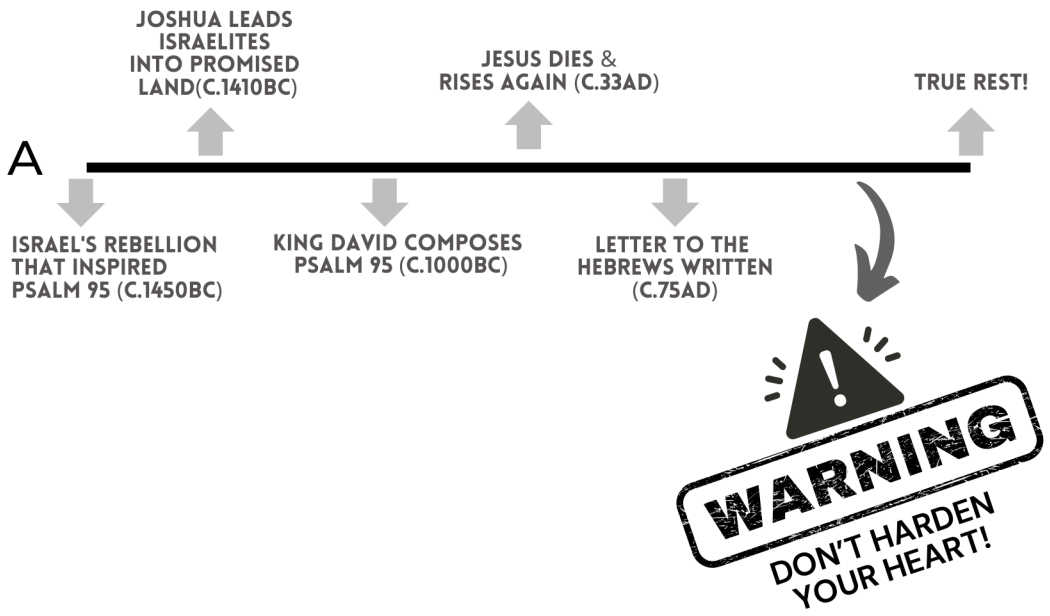
