Way

Way – Hebrew - דֶּרֶךְ

derek, a road (as well trodden); a course of life or mode of action, along, a journey, (path), way, the action of going, walking.

Way – Greek - ὁδός

Hodos, way, a travelled way, road, a travellers way, journey, a course of conduct, a way of thinking, feeling, deciding, a road; a progress (the route); a mode or means: highway.

Because of the way

And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and **the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way**. And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul loatheth this light bread. And the Lord sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died. Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the Lord, and against thee; pray unto the Lord, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people. Hind Feet in High Places:

- There was a place in her journey where all of a sudden the road turned away from the High Places, for as far as her eyes could see.

I will do a new thing

Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a **way** in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert. *Isaiah 43:18-19 NKJV*

God will make a way in the wilderness.

God's way is light

I will instruct you and teach you in **the way** you should go; I will guide you with My eye. *Psalms 32:8 NKJV*

Man's eyes take in light, God's eyes give out light.

Search me

Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:
And see if there be any wicked **way** in me, and lead me in **the way**
everlasting. *Psalms 139:23-24 KJV*

David was blind to things in his own heart, but he wanted them revealed so he could deal with them. He wanted to walk in God's way.

The way

The voice of one crying in the wilderness: “Prepare **the way** of the Lord; Make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted and every mountain and hill brought low; The crooked places shall be made straight And the rough places smooth; *Isaiah 40:3-4 NKJV*

It is a call to repentance. We should fast and pray!

- **Valley's – inferior pride**
- **Mountains – superior pride**
- **Crooked places in our wills**
- **Rough places in our lives**

God's way

Walking with Jesus is walking in God's way: How do you know you are on God's path? You say you are in a relationship with Jesus?

Honesty

- Do you wear a mask?
- Can you get honest with yourself?
 - Can you even see yourself?
- Can you get honest with God?
- Can you be honest with others?

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. ***1 John 1:8-10 NKJV***

But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all **liars** shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.” ***Revelation 21:8 NKJV***

Humility

Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with **humility**, for “God resists the proud, but gives grace to the **humble**.” Therefore **humble** yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, **I Peter 5:5-6 NKJV**

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: “God resists the proud, But gives grace to the **humble**. **James 4:6 NKJV**

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up. **James 4:10 NKJV**

And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who **humbles** himself will be exalted. **Matthew 23:12 NKJV**

Repentance

Then Peter said to them, “**Repent**, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. **Acts 2:38 NKJV**

Then He said to them, “Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that **repentance** and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. **Luke 24:46-47 NKJV**

Faith

But without **faith** *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Hebrews 11:6 NKJV

But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for “the just shall live by **faith**.” ***Galatians 3:11 NKJV***

For by grace you have been saved through **faith**, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. ***Ephesians 2:8-9 NKJV***

Redemption

Grace

We have nothing to boast about, it is all because of God's grace.

Truth
