

If you know how to worry, you know how to meditate on something. Writing out Scripture, your thoughts on Scripture, and your prayers in response to Scripture (as is done in the Life Journaling process) gets you thinking God's thoughts and gaining his insights. Writing forces you to meditate on the right things.



SCRIPTURE IN PRAYER.

"When you pray, don't babble on and on as the Gentiles do. They think their prayers are answered merely by repeating their words again and again. – Matthew 6:7 NLT



Scripture is CONTEXTUAL.

6. _____ is king.

Don't be like them, for your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask him! – Matthew 6:8 NLT

Pray like this:

PERSONAL

Our Father in heaven,
may your name be kept holy.

– Matthew 6:9 NLT

PETITION

May your Kingdom come soon.
May your will be done on earth,
as it is in heaven.

– Matthew 6:10 NLT

PROVISION

Give us today the food we need,

– Matthew 6:11 NLT

PEOPLE

and forgive us our sins,
as we have forgiven those who sin against us.

– Matthew 6:12 NLT

PROTECTION

And don't let us yield to temptation,
but rescue us from the evil one.

– Matthew 6:13 NLT

Think of Scripture as your launching platform for prayer. Feel free to recite the Lord's Prayer and other Scripture as prayer directly, but don't stop there. Let it inspire your own personal prayers.

TAKE A NEXT STEP
