"Yet there are some in the church in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes with evil. They will walk with me in white, for they are worthy. – Revelation 3:4 NLT

Think of the white robe as a picture of righteousness. White clothing has a rich, deep symbolism in the world of the Scriptures. In William Barclay's Daily Study Bible Series, he points to three significances of white clothing. (1) White clothes were for celebrations. The Kingdom of God is likened to a huge, blow-out wedding reception, and white garments were the appropriate attire for the occasion. (2) White robes represented victory. Roman cities would be decked out in white to celebrate military victories. Jesus addresses his letters to the overcomers. (3) White clothing is symbolic of purity. The believers of Revelation are portrayed in white because they have been cleansed by Jesus' sacrificial death and remain faithful and true.



Don't lie to one another. You're done with that old life. It's like a filthy set of ill-fitting clothes you've stripped off and put in the fire. Now you're dressed in a new wardrobe.
