1| Read Acts 3:1-10

Peter and John had made plans to attend a 3pm prayer service. As religious leaders going to pray, they could have brushed this lame beggar - Instead they recognized it as a divine appointment. Have you ever recognized that God had a divine appointment for you in your daily routine? Please share the story with those in your group.

2| The crippled beggar had asked for money but he ended up getting something much better. When we ask God for help, He may say "I've got something much better for you." Have you experienced this? Share your story.

3| As the people watched the beggar they could see an obvious change in his life, he once was lame and now he was walking. You may not have been the recipient of a physical healing, but all believers have been changed internally. Describe how God has changed you emotionally, mentally, etc.

4| Read Acts 3:11-26

Peter had an audience and he capitalized on the opportunity to share Jesus Christ. Have you ever been presented with a teachable moment such as this? What happened? Did anyone receive it?

5| Pastor Tom said, "Vertical focus keeps us from horizontal panic." It's easy to take our eyes off God and focus on the panic that is going on around us. Everyone share a verse with each other that helps you to keep your gaze in a vertical direction.
