1| Read John 13:31-35

With Judas gone, the final events were set in motion and Jesus looks past the cross to His soon to come glory. Our final events were set in motion when we believed. What do we now have to look forward to. What kinds of trials do we look past as we look forward?

2| The cross is where the Father and Son were glorified and where God's love was demonstrated. Finish This Statement: By Jesus death on the cross _____. Is John 3:16 engraved on your heart?

3| Reread verse 35

In what way is this a new commandment? Why is it so important that our family, neighbors, and friends see us showing love to our brothers and sisters in Christ? What are some ways we can show our love to one another? Read Galatians 6:10 & 1 John 3:14 for context.

4| Read John 13:36-38

Peter would rather believe that he should lay down his life for Jesus than that Jesus should lay down His life for Peter. Explain how Peter was wrong about salvation

5| Pastor Tom said, "When you think Jesus is wrong, it reveals something is wrong with you". Judas thought Jesus was wrong and his life ended tragically, Peter thought Jesus was wrong and his life ended triumphantly. Why was each ending so different? Have you been wrong about Jesus?
