



Christian-ish: Comfortable Faith

Read Revelation 3:14-22

- Why was Jesus' choice of the word "lukewarm" so significant for the people of Laodicea?
- How did it show they were living without purpose?
- What caused them to depend more on themselves than on God?
- Have you become more dependent on your own abilities, resources, or comfort than on God?
- Are there areas where you've settled for being comfortable instead of being faithful?

Christian-ish: A Lukewarm Faith

Which of the 5 signs of a lukewarm faith speak to you the most?

1. You crave acceptance from people more than acceptance from God.
2. You rationalize sin.
3. You rarely share your faith.
4. You only turn to God when you need something.
5. You don't look much different than the world.

Identify one action each day that requires you to trust Jesus rather than yourself and then do it. (some examples:)

- Read Revelation 2-3 and ask Jesus to speak to you.
- Pray for an opportunity to tell someone what Jesus has done in your life.
- Serve or give radically and generously.

Jesus says, "I stand at the door and knock."

- Where have you felt or heard God's invitation to deeper faith but hesitated to respond?
- What would it look like for you to open the door to Jesus and invite him in?
