His Word For The Nations

DAY 1 Read Matthew 28:18-20

[18] Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. [19] Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. [20] Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Matthew 28:18-20 NLT

- What is our answer for those who are concerned with the nations or people who have never heard the name of Jesus and place the burden on God to save them?
- God has answered that question; He created you, so in a sense, he answered the problem by the knowledge of the Gospel you possess. What do we do with that idea?
