Never Alone

Isaiah 41:10

1. God is presently with you.

"I am with you."

A. The beauty of it.

"The mystery which has been hidden from the ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:26-27)

B. The gravity of it.

"Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?" (1 Corinthians 6:19).

2. God is passionately with you.

A. No foe can daunt us.

"Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written: 'For Your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.' Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us" (Romans 8:35-37).

B. No fear can haunt us

"For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 8:38-39).

3. God is permanently with you.

A. Emphatically declared

"I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5).

B. Eternally decreed

"In hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began" (Titus 1:2).
