7. In our story, why do you think the dragon (Lucifer, Satan or the devil) has made it his mission to destroy us?
8. Where do you see the enemy at work in the world? In your community? In your family? In your life?
9. In this bigger story, why do you think God chose to make man in his image?
10. In our story, why do we listen to the enemy more than we do our Creator?

Do you believe that God wins over the enemy in the bigger story in Revelation 12:10, “Then I heard a loud voice shouting across the heavens, “It has come at last— salvation and power and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ? For the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down to earth— the one who accuses them before our God day and night.” If you believe this, how should you live?
