The End Result #2

So he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead. And for your sakes, I'm glad I wasn't there, for now you will really believe. Come, let's go see him." – John 11:14-15 NLT

Jesus told her, "I am the resurrection and the life."

Do you believe...?
