## Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 1. Stick together vs. 1-4

Summoning his twelve disciples, he gave them authority over unclean spirits, to drive them out and to heal every disease and sickness.

Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 2. Start where you are vs. 5-6

Jesus sent out these twelve after giving them instructions: "Don't take the road that leads to the Gentiles, and don't enter any Samaritan

Instead, go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 3. Stay on message. vs. 7

As you go, proclaim: 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' Matthew 10:7 (CSB)


## Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 4. Show compassion.

Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us. We plead on Christ's behalf: "Be reconciled to

Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 5. Streamline stuff. vs. 9-10

Don't acquire gold, silver, or copper for your money-belts.

Matthew 10:9 (CSB)

Don't take a traveling bag for the road, or an extra shirt, sandals, or a staff, for the worker is worthy of his food.

Matthew 10:10 (CSB)

Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 6. Seek out like minded people. vs. 11-13 When you enter any town or village, find out who is worthy, and stay there until you leave. Matthew 10:11 (CSB)

## Greet a household when you enter it, Matthew 10:12 (CSB)

and if the household is worthy, let your peace be on it; but if it is unworthy, let your peace return to you.

Matthew 10:13 (CSB)

Travel Instructions for Kingdom Service 7. Shake off rejection and keep going. vs 14-15 If anyone does not welcome you or listen to your words, shake the dust off your feet when you leave that house or town.

Matthew 10:14 (CSB)

Truly I tell you, it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah than for that town.
