- 4. According to these verses, who did God give the command to rule over his creation: the man, the woman, or both?
- 5. According to Genesis 2:18, what did God say about the man being alone? What did God call the woman he would soon make?
- 6. God made man from the dust of the ground (cf. Genesis 2:7). According to Genesis 2:21-22, from what did God make the woman?
- 7. According to Genesis 3:16, the woman would bear children in pain, and there would be strife in her relationship with the man. In other words, the two closest relationships the woman would have in life would be difficult. In your life or in the lives of women you know, have you found this to be true?

Bringing It Home

- 8. Throughout Genesis 1-3, the woman is always relating to other people. Do you believe that God has created women to be especially oriented toward relationships?
- 9. How do the relational skills of women benefit men, who are usually oriented toward their responsibilities?
- 10. Are there any specific, tangible ways in which you can improve your relationship with someone close to you?
