NOW THAT...

NEW CREATION HAS COME



If we are “out of our mind,” as some say, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. For Christ’s love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: the old has gone, the new is here! (NIV)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! (NLT)

Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away. Behold, the new has come! (BSB)

So that if any in Christ, a new creation: old things have passed away; behold, all have become new. (literal)

...the **new** creation has come...

Καινός = new in quality, fresh, not found exactly like this before, previously non-existent, far different from what was before.

...the new **creation** has come...

Κτίσις = creation out of nothing

...the new creation **has come**...

γίνομαι = to become and signifies a change of condition, state or place.
