The stories of David as a warrior: 1 Samuel 17-31

- David and Goliath - 1 Samuel 17

As a Godly warrior David did three things.:

1. David saw situations differently.

- What giants are you facing today?
- How can you redefine that giant and see the weakness and potential to take it down?

2. David saw himself differently

- How have others defined you?
- Ask God to give you an accurate picture of who He created you to be.
- See 2 Timothy 1:3, Romans 8:31-39, Philippians 4:13

3. David remained humble.

- Where do you feel anger and rage building up in your heart toward others or situations?
- Ask God to keep your heart humble. See James 4:10
