Shame is the feeling of being fundamentally flawed or unworthy







Anxiousness & Shame

God doesn't bring Shame, He takes it off of us.

When we feel anxious over shame, we have an identity issue that we need to confront.



Speak out God's truth over an incorrect belief in order to heal it and reshape that belief.



God's Character and Nature

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

Conviction

Conviction (through the Holy Spirit) tells us our behavior is coming short of the standard of who God created us to be.

Shame tells us that we are short of the standard and that there is no hope of fixing that.



Psalm 51 is connected to 2 Samuel 12

David is confronted by Nathan and figures out he's busted for murdering Uriah and stealing his wife. David is convicted and admits to his poor choices.

PRAYERS FOR AN ANXIOUS HEART
