



UNSHAKABLE Listening Guide: Week 1

Big Idea: Your worldview is not what you say you believe—it is what governs how you live.

1. The Lens of Your Life

You don't see reality as it is; you see it through a worldview lens. This lens determines how you interpret pain, success, and identity.

- **Proverbs 4:23:** Your life flows from your heart (your inner worldview).
- **Romans 12:2:** Transformation happens when your mind is renewed to see things God's way.
- **Key Truth:** Life is shaped less by what happens to you and more by how you **interpret** it.

2. The Source of Truth

In a culture where everyone does what is right in their own eyes, a Biblical worldview insists that truth is **revealed**, not created.

- **The Problem:** Feelings and cultural opinions are "shifting sands."
- **The Solution:** God's Word (2 Timothy 3:16) provides an anchor that is profitable for teaching and correction.
- **Key Truth:** You don't need a truth that agrees with you; you need a truth that can **anchor** you.

3. The Definition of Your Story

A Biblical worldview answers the three essential questions of existence:

- **Who am I?** Created in God's image, fallen in sin, but redeemable through grace.
- **What is wrong?** The root problem of the world is sin, not just circumstances.

- **How is it fixed?** Not through self-improvement, but through the rescue of Jesus—His life, death, resurrection, and reign.
- **Key Truth:** You don't fix yourself; you are **rescued**.

4. The Weight of Your Future

Where you believe you are going determines how you live today.

- **Accountability:** We will all stand before God (Hebrews 9:27).
 - **Perspective:** If eternity is real, everything we do right now carries weight.
 - **Key Truth:** If nothing matters forever, nothing matters now. If eternity is real, **everything matters now**.

Summary: The Foundation

- **The Choice:** You are either building on the "sand" of culture or the "Rock" of Christ's words (Matthew 7:24–27).
- **The Result:** When your worldview aligns with Biblical reality, you don't just think differently—you become **unshakable**.
