THE BOOK OF DANIEL

 Chapter 1: written in Hebrew because it starts in the land of Israel

- Chapters 2-7: written in Aramaic, the language of Babylon, because the events take place there
- Chapters 8-12: reverts to Hebrew because they are prophecies about the future

- Daniel: "God is my judge"
 Belteshazzar: "Baal protects the king"
- Hananiah: "God is gracious"
 Shadrach: "Under the command of Aku" (moon god)
- Mishael: "There is none like God"
 Meshach: "There is none like Aku" (moon god)
- Azariah: "God has helped me"
 Abednego: "The Servant of Nebo" (god of wisdom)
