#### **Benefits of the Resurrection**

# 1. HE EXPLAINS.

<sup>27</sup>And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he <u>explained</u> to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.

<sup>27</sup>Then he started at the beginning, with the Books of Moses, and went on through all the Prophets, pointing out everything in the Scriptures that referred to him.

#### 2. HE <u>OPENS</u>.

<sup>44</sup>Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." <sup>45</sup>And He opened their <u>understanding</u>, that they might <u>comprehend</u> the Scriptures. ~Luke 24:44-45 NKJV

<sup>45</sup>Then he opened their <u>minds</u> so they could <u>understand</u> the Scriptures.

<sup>45</sup>He went on to open their <u>understanding</u> of the Word of God, showing them how to read their Bibles <u>this way</u>.
