



Royal Priesthood

Royal: Sovereign, Authority

Priesthood: Able to be in and administer the presence of God

Royal Priesthood

To be a priest you had to:

Be a Levite and a male descendant of Aaron

At least 30 with no blemishes

Could not marry a dishonored or divorced woman or have been in contact with the dead

Be very well educated and have a deep understanding of Jewish Law Face to Face

As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him—you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

1 Peter 2:4-5

For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone," and, "A stone that causes people to stumble and a rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they disobey the message—which is also what they were destined for.

1 Peter 2:6-8

Peter ties this idea back to Isaiah 28:16, and Psalm 118:22 for his audience.

Paul also references this idea in Romans 9:33

Jesus fist mention this reference (Psalm 118:22) as an indication that He is building His temple not with stones but with people.


Emperor Nero

Christians were crucified, fed to animals or set on fire in a terrible period of martyrdom

Some christians believed he was the antichrist

1 Peter 2:13-14

For it is God's will that by doing good you should silence the ignorant talk of foolish people. Live as free people, but do not use your freedom as a coverup for evil; live as God's slaves. Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, fear God, honor the emperor.
